

Three bus stops (X29)
Bawdeswell Cemetery – Norwich Rd
Blackhorse Meadow, The Street
Maytree Farm near the School.

Bus X29 – Fakenham/Norwich – runs hourly from 0720 – 1854. The last bus home leaves Norwich St Steven's St Stop BA outside Wilkinsons at 1805. Castle Meadow Stop CB at 1810.

Bus 18 to Dereham Market, Fridays only, 1114 at the bus stop near the school opposite Maytree Farm. Leaves Dereham Marketplace at 1425.
