Bus 18 to Dereham Market, Fridays only, 1114 at the bus stop near the school opposite Maytree Farm. Leaves Dereham Marketplace at 1425.

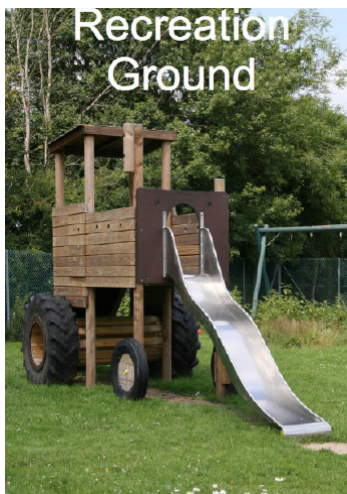
